Directions to Eisenhower Hotel & Conference Center

Due to current reconstruction and repair of nearby bridges and overpasses, directions to the Eisenhower Hotel and Conference Center have changed.

From the Downtown Center of Gettysburg: Head south on Baltimore Street for 0.4 miles. Turn right onto Steinwehr Avenue, which changes names to Emmitsburg Road along the route, and proceed 1.9 miles. You'll see a Detour Sign (Road Closed 3 ½ Miles Ahead Local Traffic Only) at the intersection of Millerstown Road but ignore it and continue traveling along Emmitsburg Road. The Eisenhower is only 2.7 miles away. Continuing along Emmitsburg Road, you'll see another Detour sign (Road Closed: 2 Miles Ahead: Local Traffic Only) in another 1.5 miles but ignore it. You'll reach the Eisenhower in an additional 1.2 miles before the construction area. You'll see our buildings on your left. The entire distance from the Center of Gettysburg to the Eisenhower Hotel and Conference Center is 5.0 miles.

From the East/West: PA Turnpike to exit 236 (Gettysburg exit). Follow Rt 15 South to the Taneytown Road Exit. Turn Left off ramp onto Taneytown Road. Turn right onto Barlow-Greenmount Road. Turn Left onto Emmitsburg Road. The Eisenhower will be on your left.

From the North: I-95 South or I-81 South to the PA Turnpike, follow East/West directions.

From the South: Baltimore/Washington, DC area - I 270 West to Rt 15 North in Frederick, MD. Follow Rt 15 North to the Taneytown Road Exit. Follow East/West directions.

From the South: I-81 North to the I-70 East toward Hagerstown, MD. Follow to Rt 15 North in Frederick, MD. Follow as above from Baltimore/Washington area.

Nearby Airports: Dulles International, Dulles, VA. Baltimore/Washington International, Baltimore, MD. Philadelphia International, Philadelphia, PA. There are several small regional airports in Harrisburg, but if you are traveling with a dog, be sure they can accommodate you.

ISWS Champions of Record, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and each Veteran Class Winner only, will be able to compete for Best of Breed

Non- Regular Classes involving Single Dog Entries for both dogs and bitches

Companion

The Companion Class is open to all neutered and spayed dogs as well as intact dogs 6 months of age or older. Dogs and bitches will be judged separately and winners will not be eligible for Best of Breed judging. No championship points will be awarded. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place. First place in each sex will compete for Best Companion.

Non- Regular Classes involving Multiple dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the following classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the get or produce and be entered in the class. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch does not need to be the owner of the get or produce. The award is based on the merits of the get or produce.

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show.

Brood Bitch Class - For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show.

Brace - A brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs must be owned by the same owner. Entries in this class must be intact (no spayed or neutered animals). Entries in the Brace class do not have to be entered in any regular class. The entry is not required to be composed of the same sex dogs. Class shall be judged on 40% conformation, 40% matching looks, and 20% difficulty of the match.

Special Awards

Award of Merit - Awards of Merit will be available which the judge may award at his discretion immediately after the selection of Best of Breed, Best of Winner, and Best of Opposite Sex. The number of Awards of Merit will be determined by the total entry at the show.

Best Puppy in Regular Classes - Best Puppy will be selected from the Regular Puppy Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to compete. (If the winner of a class is not present for judging of Best Puppy, the 2nd place in the class may not take its place. If Best of Winners or Best of Breed is from the Puppy Class, it is automatically the Best Puppy in Regular Classes.

Best Companion - Best Companion will be selected from the Companion Class winners following Best of Breed competition.

Best Bred-by Exhibitor - Best Bred by Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred By Exhibitor class winners following Best of Breed.

Best Veteran - Best Veteran will be selected from the Veteran class winners following Best of Breed. If Best of Breed is from the veteran class, it is automatically Best Veteran in Show.

Junior Handler

A Junior Handler shall be at least 9 years of age and no older than 18 years of age. Any dog shown in any Regular or Non-Regular class including any spayed or neutered dog, may be shown in the Junior Handler Class, except that the Junior Handler must own or co-own the dog, or the dog must be owned or co-owned by a member of the Junior Handler's immediate family. For the purposes of this section, the members of an immediate family are: father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including corresponding step and half-relations, or by a permanent member of the Junior Handler's household.

Versatility

A versatility rosette is being offered for the dog scoring the highest across the three venues of obedience or rally (designate which one you want to be used for versatility before judging starts), lure coursing and conformation. It is necessary to be entered in three events to be in contention for the award. In obedience or rally-obedience and lure coursing the individual scores of the dogs will be added. For conformation a separate class for versatility (different armbands/all versatility dogs are judged together in this additional class) will be judged. The raw score will be given by the judge, based on the breed standard having a perfect score of 100, and the dogs will be ranked according to the raw score received.

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes

The Puppy sweepstakes is open to all Silken Windhounds who are 3 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs 6 months of age and older shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the June 02, 2012 regular classes at the regular entry fee for that class. Indicate your sweepstakes Class with the age division on the entry form under Additional classes. Champions of record may not be entered in Sweepstakes. Entry fee is \$ 15.00

The age of a dog shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the first day of a show.
